



CONSTITUTION

1 The Name, Location, Objects and Type of Club

- 1.1 The name of the Club shall be Driffield Hockey Club (DHC).
- 1.2 The Club shall be situated in the County of East Yorkshire.
- 1.3 The objects of the Club shall be;
 - 1.3.1 The recruitment and development of children and young people into the sport of hockey as players, leaders/coaches, umpires and administrators.
 - 1.3.2 The provision of playing, leading/coaching, umpiring and administrative opportunities at a participation, development and performance level.
 - 1.3.3 To provide equity of opportunity across all areas of the club, to encourage inclusion by minority groups.
 - 1.3.4 To provide a safe, effective and child friendly environment in which to play and learn hockey.
- 1.4 The Club shall be a members club open to all.

2 Membership

- 2.1 Playing membership is open to all individuals aged 8 and over. Staff Membership is open to individuals of any age. Membership is subject to the completion of individual or parental consent (if under 18) and the payment of appropriate fees.
- 2.2 Membership fees will be charged as agreed at the Clubs Annual General Meeting.

3 Committee and Officers

- 3.1 The affairs of the Club shall be managed by the Committee of DHC except for matters reserved for the club in Annual General Meeting.
- 3.2 DHC Committee shall consist of Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, Captains, Junior Club Coach, Junior Club Captains (Boy and Girl who shall be 16 years or under) who shall be elected by the Club at the Annual General Meeting.
- 3.3 DHC Committee may appoint one or more additional officers of DHC Committee for such purposes as it may deem appropriate.
- 3.4 Three members of this committee shall be the signatories for all payments made by the Association, of which two of the named must counter sign each and every payment.
- 3.5 The Treasurer in consultation with DHC Committee shall be responsible for recording all financial income and expenditure of the Club and for presenting audited accounts at each Annual General Meeting of the Club.

4 Payments or Benefits

- 4.1 DHC Committee may appoint paid part-time staff for specific coach development projects. Such projects are at the complete discretion of DHC Committee, however they must be DHC projects. Example appointments: coaching staff for development programmes, Leader qualification course tutors etc.
- 4.2 The appointment of any and every paid member of staff must be reviewed and confirmed at each meeting of DHC.

5 Annual General Meeting

- 5.1 An Annual General Meeting of the Club shall be held in the months of June, July or August every year.
- 5.2 Notice of the time of the Annual General Meeting shall be posted for a period of at least 14 days before the date of such a meeting.
- 5.3 An Extraordinary General Meeting may be called at any time by DHC Committee or by three members making a written request to DHC Committee for such a meeting.
- 5.4 Every member of the Club shall be entitled to be present and to vote at any General Meeting of the Club and should there be equality on any voting issue the Chairman of the meeting shall have the casting vote.
- 5.5 The club shall be divided on voting issues by gender, members shall only vote on matters that are relevant to themselves. Junior matters are under the whole club. Captains shall choose their own vice captains.

6 Conduct of Members

- 6.1 DHC Committee may suspend the membership of any member whose conduct has been, in the opinion of DHC Committee, contrary to the interests of the Club.

7 Changes to the Constitution of the Club

- 7.1 These rules may be altered, added to or revoked, in accordance with clubs and association law, by majority comprising two-thirds or more of the members present and entitled to vote at any General Meeting of the Club.

8 Dissolution of the Club

- 8.1 If the Club shall pass in General Meeting, by a majority comprising two-thirds or more of the members present and entitled to vote, a resolution of intention to dissolve the Club, DHC Committee shall take immediate steps to convert all of the assets of the Club into money.
- 8.2 The proceeds of the conversion shall be used by DHC Committee firstly to discharge all the debts and liabilities of the Club. Any balance shall be passed on to the Driffield Town Cricket and Recreation Club.
